THOUGHTS FOR THE WEEK

Acts of Worship

There are several people in this world that want to offer worship to God, but does God accept any form of worship? The answer to that is simply no. We have been given several examples in scripture including Cain and Able. While Cain was offering worship to God, it was not pleasing to Him. In Genesis chapter 4 verses 6 and 7 we read “So the Lord said to Cain “Why are you angry? And why has your countenance fallen? If you do well, will you not be accepted? And if you do not do well, sin lies at the door. And its desire is for you, but you should rule over it.” God rejected the offering of fruit given by Cain and accepted the offering of animals by Abel. There is an acceptable way and an unacceptable way to worship our Lord. There are certain acts that we must preform, in spirit and in truth (John 4:24) in order to be pleasing to God. The children sing the song, “There Are Five Acts of Worship” - “there is singing, praying, preaching, giving, and the Lord’s supper.” How do we know that these are the acts of worship though? They can all be found in scripture. Singing is found in Ephesians 5:19, praying in Acts 12:5, preaching in 2 Timothy 4:2, giving in 1 Corinthians 16:1-2, and the Lord’s supper is found in Acts 20:7. All five acts are to be preformed every Lord’s day and in the manner in which God commanded them to be performed. Worship to God is not what WE think is better or even what makes US feel good. While we certainly benefit from worshipping the Lord together, the goal of worship is to be pleasing to God. Jesus, when talking to the scribes and Pharisees in Matthew 15:8-9, said “These people draw near to Me with their mouth, And honor Me with their lips, But their heart is far from Me, And in vain they worship Me, Teaching as doctrines the commandments of men.
