THOUGHTS FOR THE WEEK

The Same Yesterday, Today, and Forever

Near the end of Hebrews in the New Testament is found this significant statement; “Jesus Christ the same yesterday, and today, and forever” (Hebrews 13:8). First, this passage is not about miracles nor their duration. It is rather a summary statement of all that was written in Hebrews about Christ. Jesus is depicted in chapter one as God’s designated spokesman, priest, and king. Later, he is said to be the “apostle and High priest of profession”. “Though He were a son yet learned he obedience by the things which he suffered; and being made perfect he became the author of ETERNAL SALVATION unto all them that obey him, called of God, an high priest after the order of Melchisedec.” Thus Christians are admonished to “consider him (consider him who is unchangeable)... lest ye be wearied and faint in your minds.” (Hebrews 12:3). The next two verses are an appeal for steadfastness in the faith, an appeal based upon the fact that Jesus Christ is the same in the past, present, and future. “Be not carried about with divers and strange doctrines. For it is a good thing that the heart be established with grace; not with meats, which have not profited them that have been occupied therein . We have an alter, whereof they have no right to eat which serve the tabernacle” (Hebrews 13: 9-10). The object of the apostle is to lead and encourage his brethren not to be carried away from “the faith which was once for all delivered to the saints,” by various and strange doctrines; but to be firm and resolute in the Christians profession. And as the basis of his exhortation and argument, he reminds them that Jesus Christ, the Leader and Perfecter of the faith, is himself the same yesterday, today, and forever, without even the shadow of change (James 1:17). And as is the Leader , so also he insists should be his followers. As Jesus is always the same, so also is the Gospel. It is no more subject to change than its author. Paul wrote; “ I marvel that ye are so soon removed from him that called you into the grace of Christ unto another gospel: which is not another; but there be some that trouble you and would pervert the Gospel of Christ. But though we, or an angel from heaven, preach any other gospel unto you that which we have preached unto you, let him be accursed” (Galatians 1: 6-9). Let our Christian life be the same each and every day on this earth. (Matthew 14-16) Jesus says “You are the light of the world. A city that is set on a hill cannot be hidden. Nor do they light a lamp and put it under a basket, but on a lamp stand , and it gives light to all who are in the house. Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works and glorify your Father in Heaven”.
