THOUGHTS FOR THE WEEK

What We Believe #35

In the following verse, King David speaks to his son Solomon: "And you, my son Solomon, acknowledge the God of your father, and serve him with wholehearted devotion and with a willing mind, for the Lord searches every heart and understands every motive behind the thoughts. If you seek him, he will be found by you; but if you forsake him, he will reject you forever" (1 Chron. 28:9). The king is encouraging his son to remain loyal to the Lord in living the life of a faithful child of God. David tells Solomon if he will continue to seek God he will find him. But "if you forsake him, he will reject you forever." Here David warns Solomon what will happen if he forsakes God. He (God) will reject his child. In fact, one sadly reads that Solomon later did that very thing. He turned away from the God of Israel and no longer kept the Lord's covenant. He became unfaithful and apostatized by worshipping false, idolatrous gods (1 Kings 11:4-11).

One of the ways in which these passages can be applied today is to demonstrate that a child of God may choose to turn their back on God and forsake the Lord. It also underscores the fact that God rejects one who no longer chooses to serve him faithfully. In other words, this passage refutes the erroneous doctrine of once saved, always saved.

This is the religious teaching that once a person becomes a child of God, there is nothing they can ever do to be lost. They cannot forsake God. They cannot become unfaithful. They cannot apostatize. Rather, we are told, the child of God will remain in a saved condition no matter what sin they commit or what lifestyle of sin they may begin to live. This is the religious teaching of the "impossibility of apostasy." But when one reads and honestly accepts the teaching of the Bible, there is no way one can legitimately believe such a doctrine. The very idea that David told Solomon that it was possible for him to forsake God refutes this. What we urge all to do is read the Bible and honestly embrace its teachings no matter what the consequences. I encourage you to do this even if this means you are learning something new and different from what you were earlier taught by a denominational preacher. Many preachers wrongly teach it is impossible for a child of God to forsake God. But this is not in harmony with what the Bible teaches.
